<p>The Permit Registration must be carried when the vehicle is operated. Proof of minimal required insurance must be carried when the vehicle is operated. Permit is only good for persons named specifically on this permit. Vehicle shall be operated during daylight hours only; meaning ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset. Vehicles shall be used in alleyways in all instances of travel unless there is no other way to arrive at your destination without using a street. Vehicles will take shortest route to and from their destination. Vehicles must not exceed 10 MPH within the city of Henderson. No operating in city parks, on the levee, or the levee slopes, public sidewalks, private property (without permission) or any other public place. Only one rider per vehicle unless the seat is designed specifically for two people. This permit is not an acceptable form of permission to operate said vehicle outside of city limits.</p>
